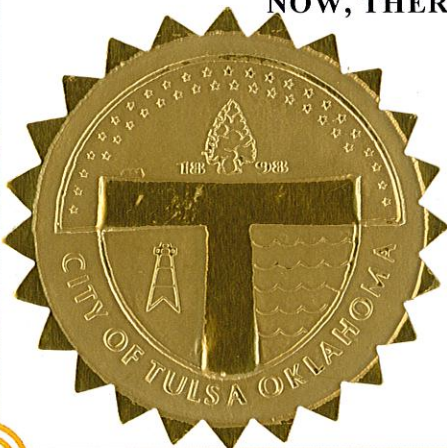
# PROCLAMATION
